Thesis notes:

A. Knowledge and information retrieval (Goals, information retrieval and use of sources)

The topic of the thesis is quite interesting and topical with application for supporting nursing student's learning. The idea of the thesis is important today in education and in the curriculum of nursing in the future. The purpose and aim are quite clear. Connection to nursing practice could have been stronger. The knowledge base is relatively short. It consists of one chapter. The concepts are used adequately. Used sources are mainly relevant and new. However, more nursing research could have been used. The sources were marked in alphabetical disorder. These have been requested to be corrected.

B. Practical skills (Execution, outputs and exploitability of the thesis)

PDSA –model has been applied in development process. The stages of the process have been described shortly. The methodological part is more like a narrative what has been done, not a structured and systematical research report. The produced material is described and presented clearly. Material is evaluated by a questionnaire.

The ethical issues are just shortly reflected, as well as the trustworthiness. More critical consideration would have been needed. Some ideas for future research and development have been mentioned.

C. Responsibility and team skills (Report layout, language, presentation and process skills)

The used language is mainly clear, partly the approach in a text is every-day language, and there are some difficulties in English language grammar. Linguistic form in the Finnish abstract is defective. The linguistic form in the Finnish abstract has been asked to be corrected.

The structure of the thesis work partly follows the LAB guidelines (e.g. there are minor mistakes in appendices, reference list of the report and reference list of the guidebook is missing). These have been asked to be corrected.

The presentation of the thesis was logical and clear. The presenters gave good concrete examples of how the general issues described in the thesis can be applied to nursing practices.

The peer review has been implemented and accepted.
