3. INFORMATION ON THE LEVEL OF THE QUALIFICATION

3.1. Level of qualification:

Master's degree (six-years course of training after completed secondary education - section 8);

Regulated profession, according to the Law of Higher Education;
The Diploma awards Master's degree in Medicine.

3.2. Official length of programme:

The complete instruction course lasts for 6 years full time study - 10 semesters and one year clinical rotations.
Curriculum comprises 2053 hrs lectures, 3403 hrs practical training, 49 examinations in 10 sessions (45 days each), and 329 days (1440 hours) pre-diploma rotations, 21 calendar days freely elective internship and 5 state exams.

3.3. Access requirements(s)

Secondary school diploma, successfully passed admission exams in Biology and Chemistry and descending score enrollment.
The maximum score is 36.00, and the minimum to be enrolled in MU-Plovdiv is 24.00.

4. INFORMATION ON THE CONTENTS AND RESULTS GAINED

4.1. Mode of study:

Full time study

4.2. Programme requirements:

Pursuant to the Law of Higher Education, the Bulgarian Health Law and the Uniform State Requirements for acquiring higher education in the Specialty of "Medicine" and regarding the specifics of the profession the curriculum is organized in stages providing transition from fundamental medico-biological and pre-clinical training to clinical /diagnosis and therapy/ after a successful study and training each one of the subjects for 6 academic years.
The owner of the Diploma must acquire general and specific medical knowledge and skills which will enable him to work independently in all kind of establishments for health prevent and clinical medical care.

In the course of his studies at Medical University-Plovdiv, and in order to implement his function, the medical doctor Master's degree achieves the knowledge in the following aspects:

I. Proficient knowledge of:

1. Structure and function of the human organism;
2. The essence and the content of health and illness and the factors that determine them;
3. Etiology, pathogenesis, clinic, diagnosis, treatment of diseases, primary and secondary prevention and rehabilitation from the sphere of first aid medicine, pediatric, infectious diseases, propaedeutics of surgery, diseases;
4. Bioethics physicians' and patients rights.

II. Sufficient knowledge of the most common diseases, knowledge on diagnostic disciplines and understanding of fundamental disciplines as follows:

Anatomy, Histology and Embryology, Physiology, Biology, Pathological Physiology, Clinical Immunology, Microbiology, Medical Genetics, Nuclear medicine, Medical Equipment, General and Clinical Pathology, Pharmacology, Neurology, Ophthalmology, Oto-Rhino-Laryngology, Dermatology and Venerology, Parasitology, Psychiatry, Occupational Diseases, Clinical Toxicology, Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation, Anesthesiology and Intensive care, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Special Surgery, Pediatric Surgery, Urology, Cardiovascular Surgery, Neurosurgery, Forensic Medicine, Orthopedics and Traumatology, Maxillofacial Surgery, Disaster Medicine, Clinical Laboratory, Radiology and Imaging Diagnostics Examination.

III. Fundamental accomplishments and skills:

1. Critical, creative and innovative thinking;
2. Realistic self-appreciation of self-potentiality;
3. Understanding of the medical history of the disease;
4. To know the general methods of the physical examination of the patient;
5. To interpret correctly the results of the diagnostic methods clinic-laboratory, X-ray, echograph, electrocardiograph, etc.;

7. Work in group/team;
8. Work in emergency and critical situations;
9. Tolerance, respect and obey the ethic and behavioral norms in medicine and society;
