- Managing infusions including blood transfusions, pain management pumps (PCA), and other continuous medication infusions.
- Performing emergency response procedures, including cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), and recognizing deterioration in patient conditions.
- Collaborating in multidisciplinary team meetings to plan and coordinate comprehensive patient care.
- Supervising and tutoring nursing students during clinical placements, providing mentorship and contributing to their professional development.

Throughout her employment, Tran Ho Phuong Uyen demonstrated excellent clinical judgment, professionalism, and a strong commitment to patient safety and team collaboration. She consistently maintained a high standard of care and contributed positively to the ward environment.
