Qualification and Award Classification

GPA: Grade Point Average

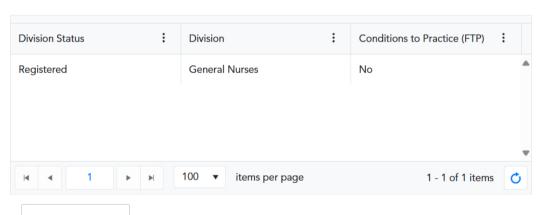
